LIGHT RAIL

Ride the light rail from downtown Minneapolis to the Airport or Mall of America for only \$1.75 (\$2.25 rush hour). Trains travel down S. 5th Street with a boarding station at Nicollet Mall. Purchase your ticket at a vending machine on the station platform. They are not sold on the train. Or, pay your fare on any bus heading down the Nicollet Mall towards S. 5th Street and ask the driver for a rail-only transfer.

NICOLLET MALL FREE BUS RIDE

Travel free through the heart of downtown Minneapolis. Look for "Free Ride" buses on Hennepin Ave between the Convention Center and Washington Ave. Approx. every 10 min. from 7am-7pm on weekdays and every 10-15 min. on evenings and weekends.
